MAKING HAY. . Clover hay cat at the period of PRACTICAL CLOCK & WATCHMAKER, florescence, and thoroughly made, has been found by repeated experi-ments, to lose about four-fifths of its weight in "making." When the flower has fallen, and the stalks have lost some of the moisture, the loss in drying is three-quarters of the weight of the crop when cut; probably a fair average where the grass CLOCKS, WEDDING RINGS, is in the state of advancement last indicated, and the labor of making is performed with a free exposure to the sun and air, one hundred pounds will be reduced to twentytwo. Clover, in all its varieties, is valuable product, and one of the best grasses for hay, if mixed with latter kinds we have for cattle. It is sapid, highly nutritive in its properties, and agrees well with all descriptions of animals. Its value, bowever, for feeding purposes, de-pends, in an eminent degree, upon the method of earling it. Formerly it was the practice to mow it in the morning, and after repeated turn-ings and shakings, to put it in cock. The mext day it was opened, turned two or three times. pitched into bunches, and finally, after all the foliage and seed had been detached by the rough handling to which it was thought necessary to subject it.
