The Sair Day.

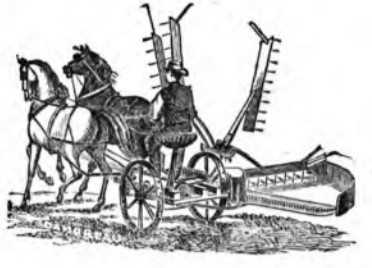
