

York County Council.

The inaugural meeting of the new County Council took place on Tuesday Jan. 28th at two o'clock in the Council Chamber of the Court House, Adelaide street, Toronto.

Mr. Jackson laid on the table the accounts and vouchers of the Newmarket High School, and the annual report of the Public School Inspector for the Southern Division.

In Committee of the Whole, Mr. Bull, seconded by Mr. Duncanson, moved that the Finance Committee be instructed to bring in a bill granting to each of the Electoral Divisions Agricultural Societies in the County the sum of \$150 for the current year.

Mr. Jackson thought that the North Riding of York should be subsidized on the same basis as last year, when it got \$25 more than the East and West Ridings.

Mr. Munroe moved that the North Riding be divided into five large townships, and should receive a larger portion of the grant.

After some discussion, and the rejection of an amendment of Mr. Munroe, embodying his views, the resolution was carried and the Committee rose.

In Council, Mr. Munroe, seconded by Mr. Cane, moved that the resolution be not accepted, but be amended by striking out the sum of \$150 for each Electoral Division Agricultural Society in the County, and inserting the following in lieu thereof, "that the Finance Committee be, and are hereby instructed to report a bill for granting \$450 to three Electoral Division Agricultural Societies in the County, to be apportioned upon the same basis as the grant of last year."
