LAW, CONCERNING NEWSPAPERS

Any person who takes a paper regularly from a post office, whether directed in his name or another's, or whether he has subscribed or not, is responsible for payment.

2. If a person orders his paper discontinued he must pay all arrears, or the publishers may continue to send it until payment is made, and then collect the whole amount, whether the paper is taken from the office or not. 3. The courts have decided that refusing to take newspapers or periodicals from the post office, or removing and leaving them uncalled for, is prima facie evidence of intentional fraud.
