

York's Wealth.

INCREASE IN PROPERTY AND POPULATION - THE NUMBER OF CATTLE - STATISTICS AS TO THE ACRES OF CLEARED AND UN-CLEARED LAND.

The returns just handed in by the assessors in the various municipalities in the County of York show a very satisfactory increase in the value of property in the wealth of the people, and in the number of the population during the past year.

The following table gives the assessment and population in the various municipalities for 1879:

In live stock the figures of the assessors show an apparent falling off in the number of sheep and hogs, but an increase in the number of horses and cattle.

The assessors, as directed by law have taken the census of the dogs, and it is interesting to know that 5102 canines make night in the County of York, mid-eous.

At the last assessment the number of acres in the various townships were 367,394. During the year following the taking of that assessment, our farmers cleared a thousand more acres.
