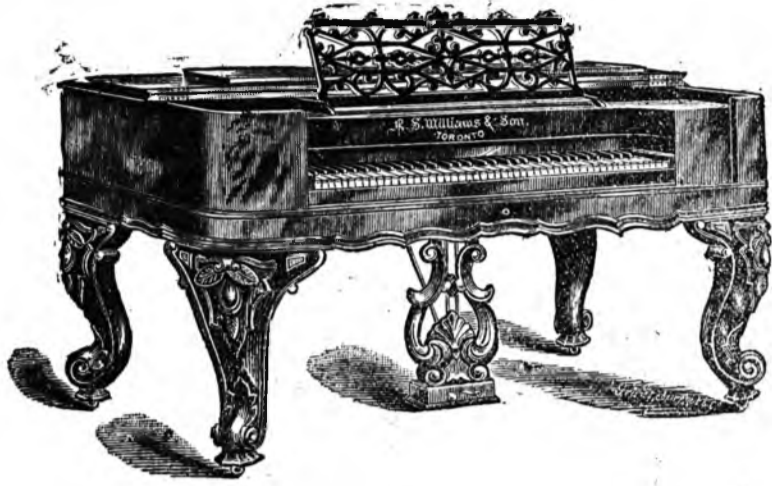

LAW CONCERNING NEWSPAPERS

1. Any person who takes a paper regularly from a
post office, in his name, or in the name of
another, or whether he has subscribed or not, is
responsible for payment.

2. If a person orders his paper discontinued, he
must pay all arrears, or the publishers may con-
tinue to send it until payment is made, and then
collect the whole amount, whether the paper be
taken from the office or not.

3. The courts have decided that refusing to take
newspapers or periodicals from the post office,
or removing and leaving them uncollected, is
prima facie evidence of intentional fraud.
