Dominion and local Leoislatures.

The next toast the "Dominion Parlament and Local Legislature," coupled with the name of Messrs Jus Beatty, M.P. and A.W. Lauder, M.P. Mr. Jas Beatty, M.P. and Leoislature at being present to do bonour to Mr. Wallace, and said that he knew from personal knowledge that no more worthy or valied representative was in the House of Cummon. Mr. Wallace was always at his post both in the House and in committee, and did his duty like a man, and stood by his chief and principles like one always ready to give a reason for everything he did.

Mr. Lauder, M.P. P., who was received with cheers, responded for the Local Legislature. He was not prepared to admit that that the matters dealt with by the Local Legislature were less important than those which fall to the functions of the Dominion Parliament. The Local House had control of the Legislation in regard to property, education, and the administration of justice, and the licensing system. The Conservative party should make a trong and united effort to wrest the reins of power from Mr. Mowat at the next election—(cheers)—by fighting him on his own ground. In Mr. Mcredith the provincial Conservatives had a leader fit in every way to head our Administration (Cheors).

A number of other toasts were proposed, and the assembly broke up at midnight.


