## ROASTED TO DEATH.

An overland express train broke loose at Tetatapi, California and ran down a steep grade, the sleepers and other cars rolling down an embankment, and cutening fire were burned. Seventeen or eighteen persons were roasted to death in the ruins. A number of persons were jummed amid the rums and roasted to death before the eyes of those who were helpless to save

eyes of those who were neighbes to save them. It is believed that eighteen passen-gers and two sleeping car porters were kill-ed or burned to death. The dead, so far as known are:—Mrs John Cassel, burned; F W Pierson, express messenger. Wright, porter of one of the sleepers, was taken out alive and died soon after. Lawrence, por-ter of the other sleeper, was burned. It is feared the wife of ex Governor Downey is among the dead. Up to ten a m. Saturday, seven bodies were taken out, some being burned beyond recognition.


