

Markham Township Council.

The Council met at Mrs Page's Hall, Unionville, on Monday the 15th. The Clerk in the chair, Wm Eakin, Receiver David James, 1st Deputy-Reeve; F K Reesor 2nd Deputy; A Foster 3rd Deputy, and W H Lundy Councillor, having subscribed to their declaration of qualification and of office took their seats. The Reeve in the chair.

Mr James seconded by Mr Forster, moved that the Council do release W H Lundy, one of the sureties of Mr J Lownsbrough, collector, from any further liability as such surety to this municipality, and that the seal of this corporation be attached to this resolution.

Mr James seconded by Mr Lundy, moved that all resolutions giving grants to the destitute poor of this municipality, be and the same are hereby rescinded.

Mr Forster seconded by Mr Lundy, moved that the Treas pay W G Lloyd \$36, being half amount for gravel put on north town line, Whitechurch Council having paid a like amount. Thos Farmer overseer.

Mr James seconded by Mr Reesor, moved that the Treas pay to the order of C J Brodie \$35.66, being one-half of amount for 792 feet of plank at \$9 per thousand, for townline between Markham and Whitechurch.

Mr Reesor introduced a By-law to provide for investment of Municipal Loan Fund debts, which was read and passed.

Mr James introduced a By-law to appoint Assessors and Amend By-law 325. The By-law was passed, fixing the salaries as follows: Assessors each \$75; Collectors, \$75; Constables at elections \$1.25 per diem; polling booths \$3 per diem.

Mr Forster introduced a by-law to appoint Assessors and auditors, which was passed, as follows: T Thomson, assessor for east half, Edward Eckardt for west half, and Wm Braithwaite and John Miller auditors. The by-law was read a third time and passed.

Mr James seconded by Mr Forster, moved that the Treas pay Robert Goodyear \$4, for putting timber in grade on Clark-on's hill, between Lots 20 and 21, in 4th Con, to carry surface water to the side.

Mr James, seconded by Mr Forster, moved that when this Council adjourns it stands adjourned until the 17th of February next ensuing.

Mr Forster, seconded by Mr Lundy moved that a grant of \$50 be made to meet a grant of a like amount from Whitechurch, to gravel north town line between 5th and 9th Cons., and that Mr Reesor and the mover be commissioners to expend the same, payable on order of commissioners when work is completed.

On motion the Council adjourned.

ROASTED TO DEATH.

An overland express train broke loose at Tetatapi, California and ran down a steep grade the sleepers and other rolling down an embankment, and cutting fire were burned. Seventeen or eighteen persons were roasted to death in the ruins.

A number of persons were jammed amid the ruins and roasted to death before the eyes of those who were helpless to save them. It is believed that eighteen passengers and two sleeping car porters were killed or burned to death. The dead, so far as known are: Mrs John Cassel, burned; F W Pierson, express messenger. Wright, porter of one of the sleepers, was taken out alive and died soon after. Lawrence, porter of the other sleeper, was burned. It is feared the wife of ex-Governor Downey is among the dead. Up to ten a. m. Saturday, seven bodies were taken out, some being burned beyond recognition.

The Clerk stated that the first business would be the selection of a Warden. Messrs Jackson, Marriott, Watson, Richardson and Porter were nominated, but Mr Porter withdrew in favor of Mr Marriott. On the third ballot the vote stood as follows: Jackson 23; Watson 22; and Mr Jackson was duly elected Warden for the year. The Warden then took the chair, and thanked the Council.

The following members were appointed as a committee to strike the standing committees for the year: Eakin, Barkin, Bowen, Porter, Watson, Richardson, and Marriott.
