#### BY-LAW NO 99

To provide for draining certain parts of the Village of Richmond Hill, for the purpose of better perserving the health of the inhabitants residing in such parts, and forlevying the necessary rates for the payment of the expenses attending the construction of said drainage, Provisionally adopted the sixteenth day of July, A. D., 1883.

WHEREAS a majority in number of the owners, as shewn by the last revised assessment roll, of the property hereinafter set forth to be benchted by the drainage have petitioned the Council of the Village of Richmond Hill, praying "that in the interest of the sanitary condition of the Village, and for the prevention of Typhoid and Malarial Fevers and other diseases, you would pass a By-Low to levy a frontage tax sufficient to lay a box drain, not less than ten inches square, in the ditches on each side of Yonge street, frem the North boundary of A. Wright and Sons south to the stone culvert crossing Yonge street, opposite Dufferin street,—and on the west side of Yonge street from Richmond street north to said culvert, and that the work be proceeded with as soon as possible."

And whereas, thereupon the said Council procured an examination to be made by John T. Stokes, Esquire, being a person competent for such purpose, of the said locality proposed to le drained, and has also procured plans (hereunto annexed) and estimates of the work to be made by the said John T. Stokes and an assessment to be unade by but of the real property to be benefited by such drainage, stating, as nearly as he can, the proportion of benefit, which, in his opinion, will be derived in consequence of such drainage by every road and lot or portion of the said-down T. Stokes in respect thereof, and of the said drainage, being as follows:

Also a drain across Yonge street to convey the drainage from the drain on the said west side to the head of Dufferin street.

"I begt to say that on the 8th day of the present month. I made a survey of the proposed works. I found the length of drain on the west side of the street to be 1330 frot long and that on the east side 892 feet, of that on the west side 438 feet may be an 8 inch drain, while all the remainder should not be less than 12 inches internal diameter, excepting the plece crossing Yonge street being an additional length of 50 feet, which should not be less than 16 inches. I think, however, the culvort crossing Yonge street, opposite Dufferin street, his, by by a little decipening, be utilized as an outlet drain.

The cost of such works should not exceed, for straight drain \$73-100 per yard, if constructed of wood, and the grillies at the north end, if constructed of wood with iron grating, should not exceed \$8.00 each, the wood for said gullies being bedar 6 inches tittle. I therefore estimate the cost of the works at the above rates.


