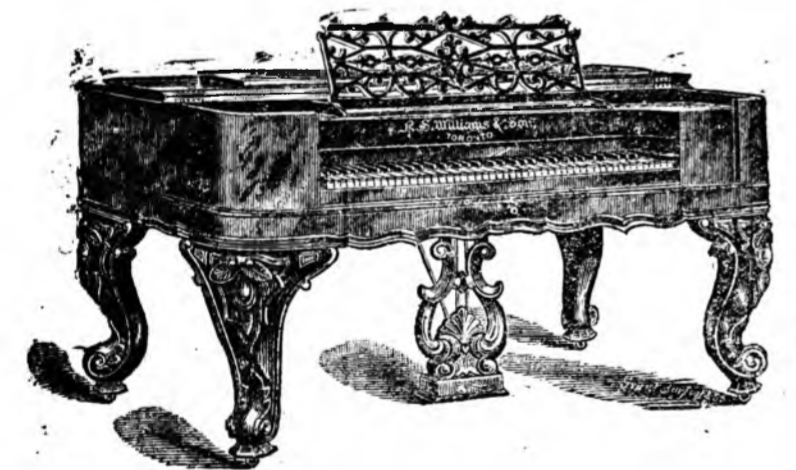

### The Mormon Problem.

The Senate of the United States has just passed a bill dealing with the Mormon question in Utah that is certainly one of the most stringent measures ever passed to be by a representative body. Practically this measure annuls the constitution of the territory, in so far as it has power to deal with the Mormon Church. It annuls all measures of the Legislature incorporating the Church of the Latter Day Saints, and it especially annuls any acts of the so-called General Assembly of the State of Deseret incorporating this church. The President of the United States is authorized to appoint a commission of fourteen persons who are to be trustees of this church, and this commission shall make to the Secretary of the Interior for the United States an annual report of all the property, the business affairs and operations of the church. It annuls all territorial laws, creating or relating to the Perpetual Emigration Fund Company, and consents all the property in its hands, devoting the proceeds to a general sale of its assets to the use of the common schools of Utah. Moreover, from this time onward, any corporation or association, having for its object the bringing in of any person for any purpose whatever, is made unlawful. If these measures are practical they will put an end to one of the worst evils of the Mormon Church, the addition to its numbers yearly of thousands of the most ignorant of the population of Europe, who are being constantly enticed to Utah by the agents of the "Perpetual Emigration Fund Society." In addition to this the board of trustees will—if they succeed in doing anything, which is to be doubted—be in a position to discover whether a portion, at least, of the power which the Mormon Church wields over its followers, is due to the fact that the greater part of them are always in debt to the church. That portion of the measure dealing with the question of polygamy is especially severe. When this crime against nature was declared to be a crime against the law of the United States, it was found impossible to enforce this law as the women swore that they were not the wives of their polygamous husbands, and when an attempt was made to induce these men for adultery, the territorial legislature passed a measure providing that no action could be taken against an adulterer except by one of the interested parties. This present measure provides that this territorial act shall be annulled, and fixes a greater penalty for this crime than for polygamy. It also provides that the lawful husband or wife of a person indicted for polygamy, bigamy or adultery may be compelled by extraordinary methods to appear as a witness, and prosecutors for these offences may be compelled five years after their perpetration. All marriage ceremonies, not only in Utah, but in any territory in the United States, must be filed before the United States Courts, the penalty for neglecting to do this is a fine of not less than one thousand dollars or two years' imprisonment, or both. This does not by any means exhaust the repressive clauses of this measure. The electoral divisions of the territory are to be rearranged by the United States officials, and all territorial measures for the numbering of votes in such a manner that their ballots may be identified are annulled. The power of appointing the superintendents of common schools is to be vested in the United States. Women are deprived of the franchise, and laws of Utah conferring rights of inheritance upon illegitimate children are annulled. This bill has yet to pass the House of Representatives, and be assented to by the President before it becomes law, and if it does it is hard indeed to see by what subterfuges the Mormons may be able to evade its stringency. Mormonism is a stern evil to contend with, one that threatens the future of the entire western portion of this continent, and certainly it has been sternly dealt with. It is absolutely impossible that in any country a sect may be allowed to band itself together to break the laws and defy the authority of the central government, as the Mormons have done. The United States Government has so far done nothing to interfere with liberty of conscience, but only with gross license of conduct.
