





Sir John Macdonald has taken Earncliffe, Major Holbech's residence at Ottawa, for two months. Major Holbech is with his regiment in Egypt.


The brother of Walsh, who was banged recently at Galway, has been found guil-ty as accessory to the murder of Constable Kavanagh, and sentenced to be hanged.
