

MARKHAM COUNCIL.

The Markham Council met at Unionville on June 28th. Members all present. Communications were read from O. & Q. Railway, declining to change the name of Green River Station to Belford; from T. J. Dobson, respecting the cutting of a hill on 2nd line.

Petitions were read from A. Hoover and others, asking a grant for 7th line; from G. E. Reesor, for grant for side line between lots 10 and 11 in 9th and 10th Cons.; from Jas. Dimma, for grant for 11th line; from W. Patterson, for grant for 6th line.

The following grants were made:—\$25.00 for 7th line; \$50.00 for Markham and York townline; \$6.00 for 3 culverts in 6th Cons.; \$100.00 for sideline east of Markham Village; \$25.00 for 11th line; \$36.00 for 4 road scrapers.

Notice of introduction of By-Law to close German Mill road was read. Commissioners were appointed to Whitechurch townline, 5th line and 10 line.

Paid Wm. Boynton, jr., \$8.00 for three sheep killed by dogs.

A resolution was adopted encouraging the use of macadam in those parts of the township that are far from gravel pits. Adjourned until August 16th.
