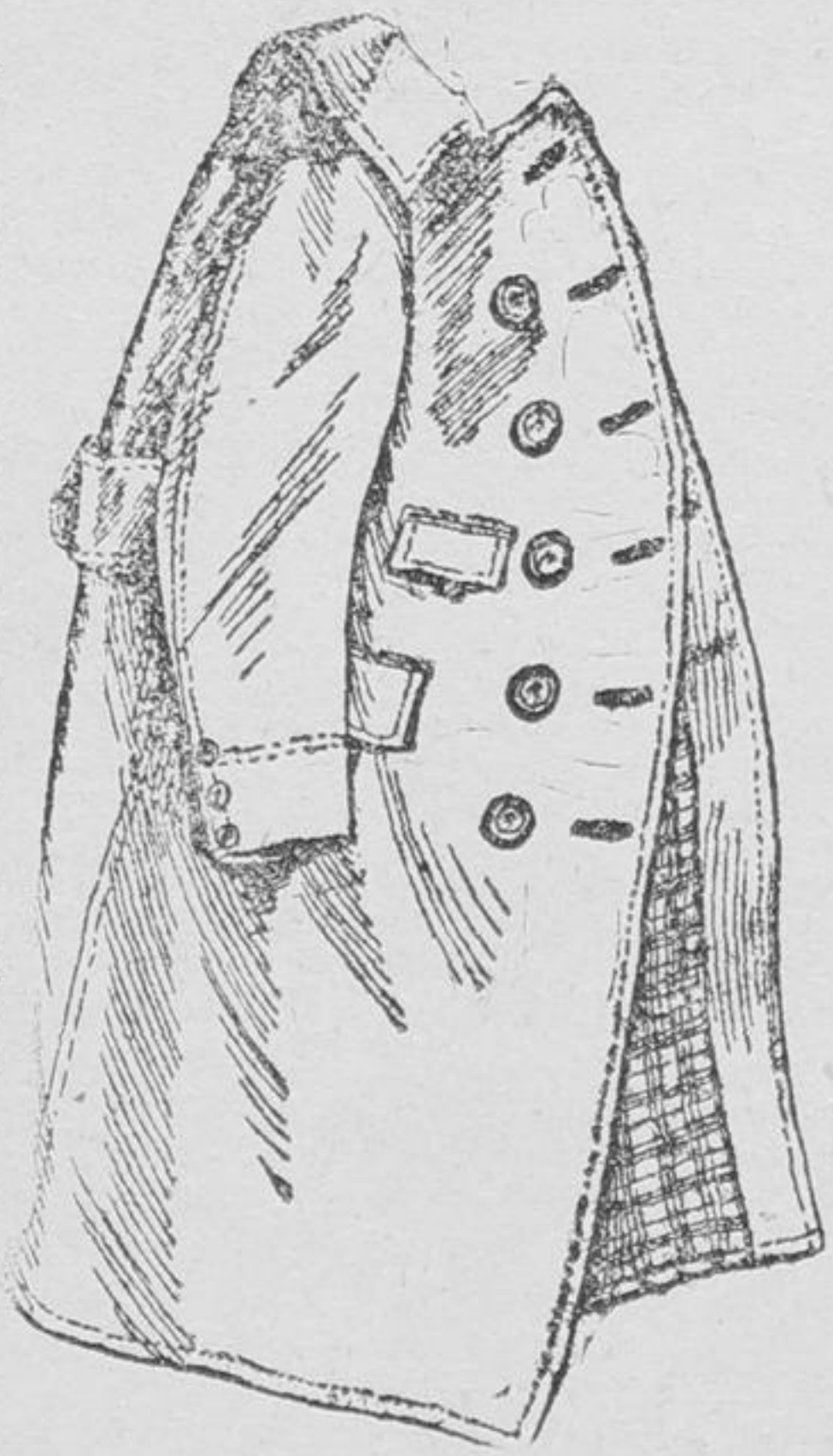


# An Honest Ring

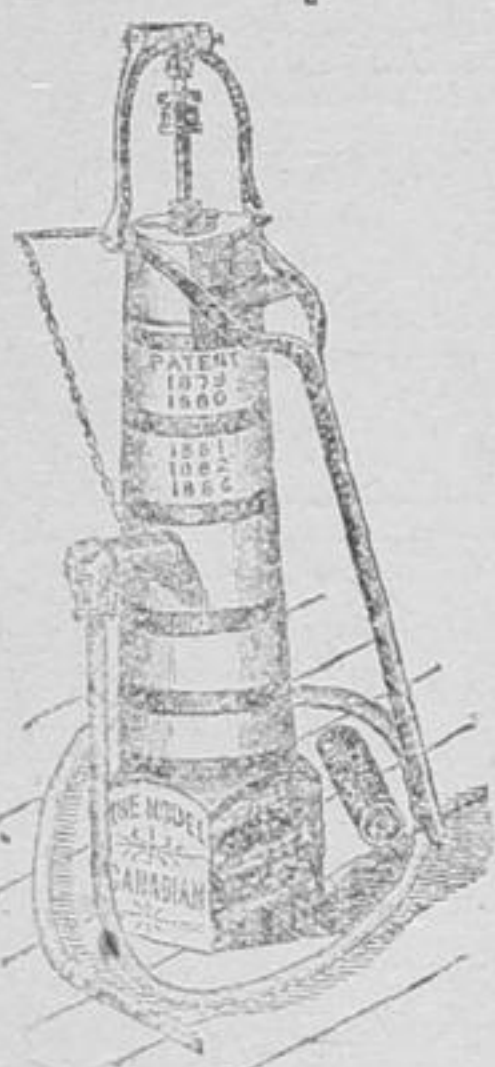
