A Cannibal Cemetery.

Although the battaks of Sumatra are still ferocious cannibals, they, like other anthropophagic races, are by no means in that low state of civilization, so far as handicrafts are concerned, that their cannibalism would

lead one to suppose. This is especially visible in the really beautiful and artistic deadhouses in which they deposit their dead for several days before burial. The side walls are of carved wood, and the roof is covered with beautiful mats of the most elaborate design. The dead bodies lie in coffins which are built in the shape of a boat, richly adorned with arabesques and carved figures. Some of the tribes burn their dead, but the majority of them take them from the deadhouse and hang the coffin between to poles several yards above the ground, or they sew the bodies in mats which are similarly suspended between two poles.

There the corpse is left to decay in the burning sun, until it returns to dust, and the winds scatter it in all directions.






