The Ontario Board of Health Will Purchase a Quantity of Serum for the Hospitals of Toronto.

It is nounced that the Provincial Board of Health will purchase as soon as possible a quantity of anti-diphtheric serum from the Pasteur Institute in Paris for dis tribution amongst the isolation hospitals in Toronto. As far as we know, the Pasteur Institute will not be able to supply this new virus for a couple of months yet, and be commended for looking so far ahead that interest to suffering humanity in general they will be able to give some of the first demonstrations of its application outside of mended for two reasons. This new diphtheria cure, from the public point of view, is certainly the most interesting discovery that has been made by medical science, and the experiments so far made with it seem to have established its success at least as well as the protection of vaccination against smallpox.




