

TO NUMBER THREAD.

The question, "Why is spool cotton numbered as it is, and why are the figures not used in regular order?" is often asked. The explanation is this: The numbers on the spools express the number of "hanks" which are required to wind a pound. The very finest spinning rarely exceeds 300 hanks to the pound, while in the coarsest there is about half a pound to each hank. The more common qualities, however, those the pound, and the spools on which it is wound are numbered ten to fifty in accordance.




