## EXTRA-PROVINCIAL COMPANIES.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under the provisions of Section 104 of The Ontario Companies' Act, every company, NOT INCORPORATED BY OR UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF AN ACT OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ONTARIO, which now or prior to the first day of November, A. D. 1897, carries on business in Ontario, HAVING GAINED ITS PURPOSE OR OBJECT, for the carrying on of which a company might be incorporated under the said Act, shall, on or before the first day of November, A.
