Eighteenth Annual Report

The eighteenth annual meeting of the shareholders of the Federal Life Assurance Company of Canada was held at the head office of the Company in Hamilton, on March 6, 19 o. The managing director, David Dexter, presented the following reports and financial statement.

DIRECTORS' REPORT.
