ANOMALOUS BRITISH TITLES.

The titles of the members of the House of Lords are as anomalous as many of the powers of the House itself. The Duke of Devonshire owns just a few haudreds short of 200,000 acres, but not an acre in the county of which he is the titled Duke, although his possessions are spread over eleven counties in England and three in Ireland. Of the Earl of Derby's 70,000 acres not one is in the County of Derby.
