**Markham Council.**

Council met at Unionville, on Tuesday, Nov. 19. Members all present. Minutes of former meeting read and confirmed.

Messrs. F. K. Reesor and Wm. Robinson were heard asking that the Township Council pass a by-law to assume that portion of Markham Village known as Vinegar Hill, lying south of the River Rouge, as per petition presented last meeting.

Sisley-Summerfeldt-That the members of this council visit the locality about Markham village asked to be taken over by the township, and take all matters into consideration and act accordingly.-Carried.

Report of medical health officer, Dr. Watson, regarding his work, was considered very satisfactory. Smallpox had threatened the township but by vigilance it had been kept beyond the limits. The sanitary condition of the township generally was good.

Summerfeldt-Morrison-That the treasurer be and is hereby authorized to pay D. & G. Harrington \$104.60 for material furnished the municipality up to date.-Carried.

Eckardt-Summerfeldt-That the mover be commissioner to repair or fill up the culvert opposite lot 9, Con. 6, as he may deem necessary.

Eckardt-Summerfeldt-That the receiver be a commissioner to repair Locust Hill bridge between Lots 10 and 11, Con. 10.

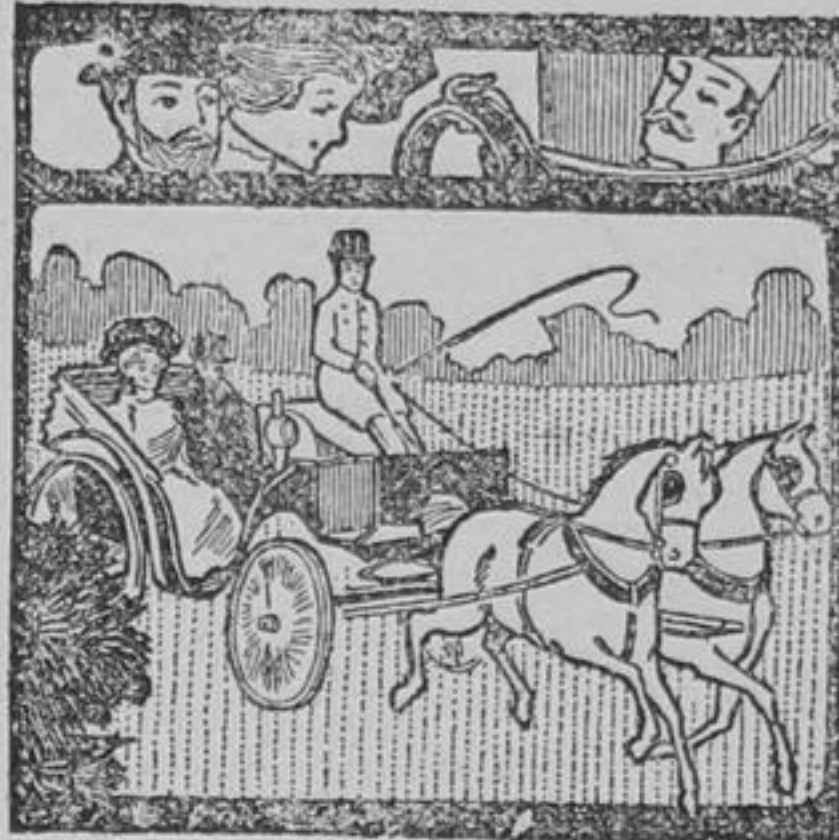

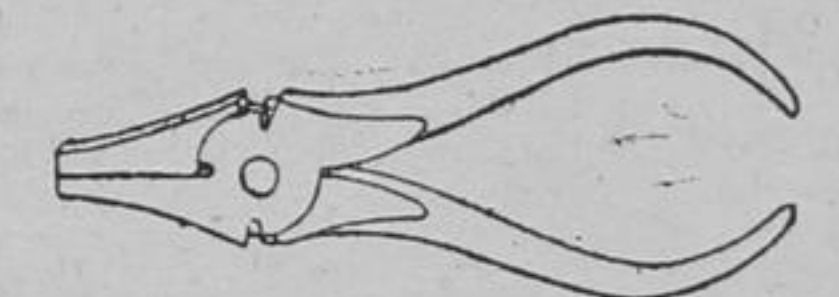

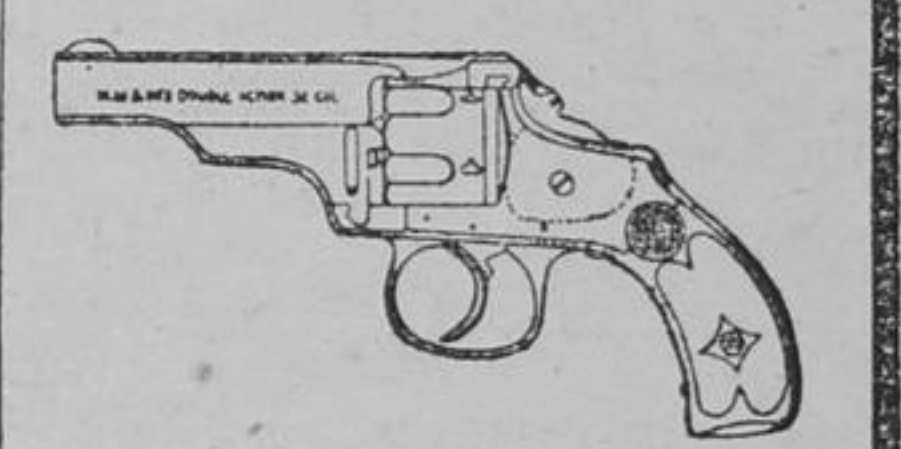
