LEVELS ABOVE LAKE ONTARIO

We have frequently been asked about the levels from certain points on Yonge Street above Lake Ontario, and have heard various opinions expressed. The following extract, with the tabulated levels, will be interesting to many of our readers. It is an authentic record by a distinguished Professor of Trinity College, Toronto; he was awarded twenty pounds for his essay.

Extract from a pamphlet in the Ontario Parliament Library entitled "Journal and Transactions of the Board of Agriculture of Upper Canada, October 1855.—Prize County Agricultural Reports.—Agricultural Report of the United Counties of York, Ontario and Peel, April 1st, 1859, by H. Y. Hind, Esq., of Trinity College, Toronto."

Respecting the level above the sea, and at certain points along Yonge Street above Lake Ontario, Mr. Hind says: "The ascent from Lake Ontario to the utmost elevation of the Ridges on the line of the lowest level is rather abrupt, and is attained 21 miles from the City of Toronto in a direction due north. On the lines of the Ontario, Simcoe and Huron Railway the altitudes subjoined are those for every two miles between Toronto and the level of Lake Simcoe":
