Party men will doubtless continue to express their feelings on this longtalked-of case. A careful perusal of the judges' report, however, will satisfy fair minded people that the commissioners could not come to any other conclusion. Every opportunity was given Mr. Gamey and the prosecution to make good their case, and there is reason to believe the eminent judges were perfectly impartial. The scope of the investigation was unrestricted, and every tittle of evidence at all revelant to the ease was allowed. The report will probably be discussed in the Legislature the latter part of the week.
