TINNED MEATS.

There is a good demand in Great Britain for tinned meats but complaints are made that Canadian tinned meats, etc., are often colored next the tin by some acid action.

The quality of Canadian beef and mutton is preferred to the imports from other countries, the packs of which countries are often filled with meats from which extracts have been taken to make fluid meat preparations.

Most of Canadian tinned beef and mutton is put up in tins holding not over two pounds of meat. There is a great demand for tins holding six pounds especially for War Office and Naval Stores.

A bill is before the Legislature having for its object a blow at the saw-off system in election trials. It was shown that after the 1893 elections 76 petitions were entered against the return of members and of those only about half a dozen went to trial.
