

#### LONDON'S BUSY BRIDGES.

In twelve hours 22,118 people cross Westminster Bridge on foot and 7,-051 passengers go over by omnibus. At Blackfriars Bridge 31,385 pedestrians cross in twelve hours and 5,-399 passengers in omnibuses. Every day 1,350 electric trams are run to and from Westminster Bridge, and last year a total of 53,000,000 passengers were carried. To Blackfriars Bridge there are 566 cars a day, and the number of passengers last year was 38,000,000.
