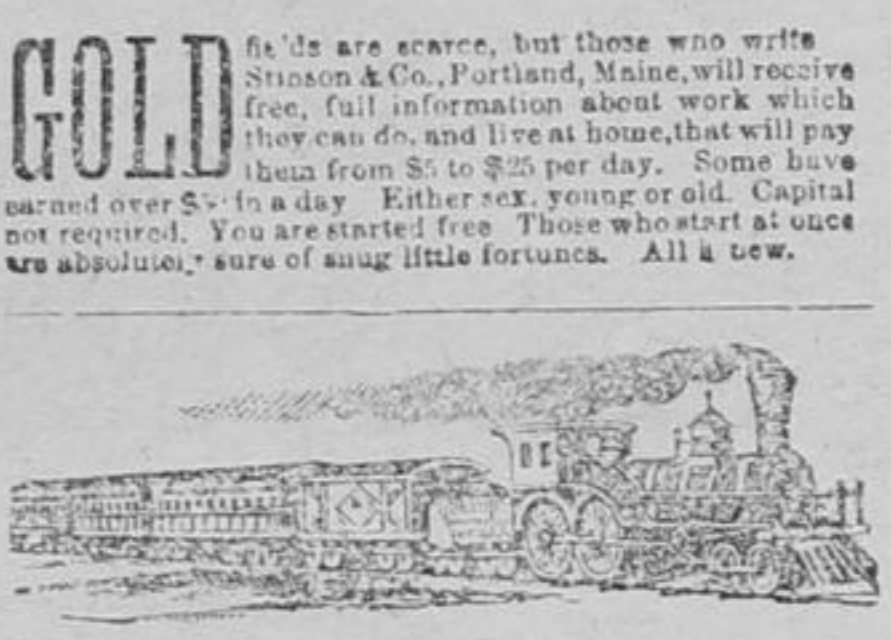

Starting Monday, Sept. 30, will run first two days of each week during October and November, up to and including Nov. 19, 1907.
