# FATAL SLEEPING SICKNESS.

#### Prof. Koch Finds That Crocodiles are able to find one during the day. the Cause.

Professor Koch has given a most interesting account of his recent experiments in East Africa to a special correspondent of the Lokalanzeiger, of Berlin, Germany.

The professor, who is in the best of health, said that he had been living for the last eighteen months on a desolate island belonging to the Sesse za, with an army medical sergeant as his sole while companion.

They dwell in a straw hut similar to those occupied by the natives and saw only three Eugapeans throughout their stay, two of them being Viennese doclors and the third a German official. . Their only means of communication with the world was a primeaval native Loat fashioned out of a tree trunk, which conveyed them to the mainland.


Sleeping sickness is particularly prevalent in the Sesse Islands, the inhabitants of which are gradually dying off through the ravages of the disease.
