

#### FINDING A HORSESHOE.

It is necessary to notice how the horseshoe lies before picking it up. If the ends are away from one the sign is that fortune will be within grasp; but by extravagance, carelessenss, or the operation of rogues. it may depart almost as soon as it comes. A sign to take care is given, therefore.

The right thing to do is to turn the horse shoe around, so that the ends are toward the finder, before picking it up. And in carrying, it home it is correct to hold it with the ends upward, or the earth will attract itself the promised fortune.


