#### TORPEDOES AND DESTROYERS Types of Each Rapidly Changing in the British Navy.

The day has gone by when the torpedo can be regarded as an unreliable instrument of war of strictly limited use. To-day the British Navy is about to be equipped with a torpedo which will carry a destructive charge of upward of 200 pounds, and will possess an effective range of over 7,000 yards, which it will be able to cover at an average speed of thirty-one krots.

Such a weapon, says Cassier's Magazine, is bound to influence battle tactics owing to its range and the accuracy with which it runs. The new torpedo in association with improved gunnery methods has already banished the familiar 6 inch gun from the newer battleships and battleship cruisers. They are to have a displacement of from 930 to 1,030 tons, with a speed of twenty-seven knots only; they will mount five 12 pounder guns, and be fitted with two torpedo tubes. The building of a destroyer is a special trade based upon scientific data and carried out with a delicacy and accuracy of workmanship which is not to be found, because it is not required, in larger vessels. The establishments which devote themselves to the construction of such craft are a national asset of no mean importance at a time when the torpedo is looming with increasing menace on the horizon.


