

In a detailed statement given out by the university authorities rec-ently it was pointed out that the subject of the experiment was a young man 22 years of age, who was normal in all respects and who weighed 157 pounds when the investigation was inaugurated.

statement continues: "In experiments of this sort, it is customary to use a simple diet in order that the chemical analysis of the foods may not entail any undue labor. In this instance the daily diet consisted of three-quarters of a pound of crackers, three ounces of corn flakes, two ounces of peanut butter, one and one-half ounces of sugar, three ounces of butter, one quart of milk, nine-tenths of a quart of water, and, in addition during the water period, three quarts additional of water were added to the daily menu. Of the nine-tenths quart of water taken daily during the preliminary and final periods three-quarters of it was taken between meals.'


