Got Disease From Wearing Infected Hair Switch.

Four weeks ago Miss Mamie Gillespie was head of the glove department in one of Pittsburg's (Penu.) largest stores, and to-day she is on a little island off the North Carp-lina coast suffering with a majenant growth of leprosy caused by wearing an infected human hair switch. As a result almost every employer of female labor has ordered that after the first of the month, none of the women are to wear false hair of any sort.

Some three months ago, Miss 'aillespie went to the hair department of the store where she was employ. ed, and purchased a handsome blonde switch. After wearing it about two weeks, her body, from the breast up became covered with a malignant growth which frightened the young woman. She went to Dr. L. M. Golden, who became alarmed, and consulted several leading physicians, before he finally announced that the disease was leprosy, and that Miss Gillespie would have to be taken away and isolated, where she would not contaminate others.

The girl's horror was pitiable, and she stoutly refused to be taken away, until the government had investigated the matter.

It took several weeks for the U. S officials to trace the lock of golden hair, but it was discovered to have been imported from an island in the Caribean sea, where the Cuban Government sends its worst cases of leprosy. The hair had been sold in one of Pittsburg's most prominent stores, and this news caused a sensation, but the young woman had to go. Dr. Golden had warned all of his patients to stop wearing false hair, as this may be only the first case of the kind. -


