In this case, therefore, since there was no immediate danger of the man's dying, to heal his hand would be a breaking of the law. But only the malice of the accusers of Jesus would have so inter-

11. He said unto them-The question had been launched with the purpose of creating a discussion of what things may be done on the Sabbath and what things may not. The answer of Jesus put all argument to an end, simply by raising the subject to a higher level. The rule of the rabbis was, that if a sheep should fall into a pit on the sabbath day, it should first be ascertained whether it had been injured. If so, and only on this condition, it might be dragged out and killed. But, as often, the Jews found a way of getting around this hard rule. The indignation of Jesus was therefore justified, when he saw these legalists much more concerned about their property than


