A HUGE BAROMETER.

The largest barometer in the world was recently set up in the Italian town of Faenza, the birthplace of Torricelli, who discovered the barometer and the "vacuum" which perpetuates his name. The liquid used is purified oil rendered free from air, and this gives a column over eleven metres in height. Owing to the very small amount of evaporation an oil barometer is much more accurate than one filled with any other liquid except mercury, and the long column makes it very sensitive.

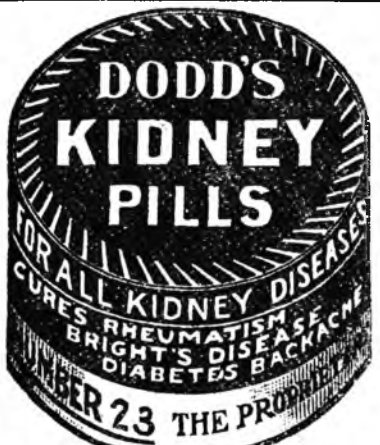

QUEEN MARY'S DISTINCTION.

Third Princess of Royal Lineage to be Consort of English King.

In a London paper it is said that Queen Mary, the consort of King George V., is the first English Princess of royal lineage who has been Queen Consort of England for many centuries.

In searching English history since the Norman Conquest we can find only two English Princesses of royal birth who have married English Kings: Queen Elizabeth, the wife of Henry VII., and Queen Matilda, the wife of Henry I. In Elizabeth of York, who was a daughter of Edward IV., King Henry VII. secured the legitimacy of his dynasty. In Matilda, the wife of King Henry I, the union of Norman and Saxon dynasties was secured, for she was a daughter of Queen Matilda, the wife of Malcolm III., King of Scotland, and a granddaughter of Edmund Ironsides, the Saxon King.

In the Hanover dynasty William and the four Georges married Germans. Among the Stuarts Queen Anne and Queen Mary II. were born of an English mother, but Anne Hyde, the daughter of Clarendon, was not a Royal Princess. From the Conquest to the Tudor dynasty, every King of England married a French Princess, with the exception of Edward IV., who married, so it was said, Anne Woodville, the daughter of Earl Rivers, who did not claim to be an English Princess.

Consequently Queen Mary III. claims the honor of being with Matilda and Elizabeth of York a Queen Consort of English royal birth.
