The Markham Sun, Conservative, takes a very sensible view of the situation at Ottawa. Last week that paper had the following editorial note: "It looks now as if the end of the session at Ottawa was in sight. The government has decided that very little more talking will be done on their side of the house in the hope that the opposition would follow suit. That the reciprocity bill will be passed is now admitted by all. The opposition has been assured that no election will take place till after the census is taken and the re-distribution which must necessarily follow. In this the government position seems well taken. It would not be fair to a large section of the Dominion to hold an election on the eve of a census and re-distribution."

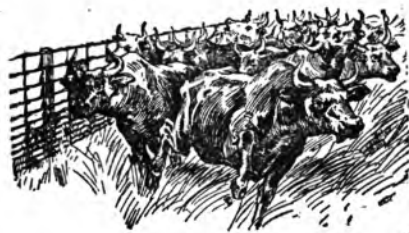
