"Yes, dear, I know I did. But—well, I wouldn't have accepted him if he hadn't made such a perfectly dreadful threat."

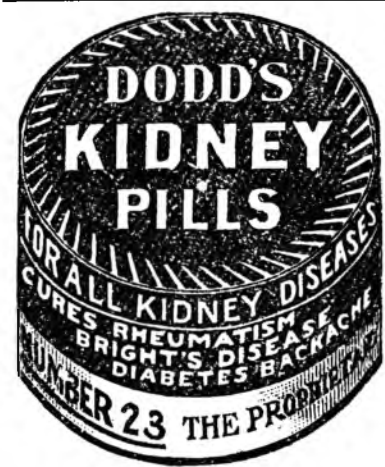
"Oh! That old stall about rushing out and committing suicide?"
