

Application to Parliament.

TAKE NOTICE that application will be made to the Legislature of the Province of Ontario at the next session on behalf of the Town of North Toronto for an Act:---

(a) To repeal sub-section 5a of Cdap. 114, 9 Edw. VII, (1909) except as to water mains already commenced, and to substitute for such subsection a clause enabling the said Town to exend its waterworks system and to lay all new water mains as local improveall new water mains as local implove ments under the provisions of the Lo-cal Improvements Sections of the Mu-nicipal Act, being Uhap. 58, 1 Gec. 5, (1911) and to levy the whole cost there-of (excepting for flankages and street intersections) by frontage tax on the intersections) by frontage tax on the properties benefitted. (b) To have it declared that Sec. 14, Chap. 88, 10 Edw. VII, (I910) respect-ing the assessment of farm lands in towns and villages shall no longer be applicable to the said Town. (c) To prohibit any railway com-pany or street railway company from carrying freight mon any highway carrying freight upon any highway within the said municipality. (d) To extend to the said Town the provisions of Subsection (b) of Section 541a of the Consolidated Municipal Act (1903) as amended, to control the location of buildings used for certain trades. (e) To enable the Council of the said town to direct private individuals or companies dedicating lands for public highways to make the same such greater width than sixty six feet as the Council may deem necessary. (f) To enable the Council to enforce fair wage clause in all Corporation contracts. (g) To enable the Council to regu-late the size of building lots within the Town. To amend The Land Titles Act to admit the filing of agreements for the purchase of rights-of-way or easements for sewer purposes. (i) To extend to the said Town the provisions of Sub-section 1 of Sec. 538 of the Municipal Act for remunerating members of the Council. (j) To amend in the case of the said Town Section 4 of the Municipal Waterworks Act, Chap 235, R. S. O. 1897, by extending the limit mention-ed in the said section from ten miles to thirty miles. T. 
