CHASING THE JEWELS.

The mystery of the Crown jewels, which disappeared from Dublin Castle a few years ago, has never been cleared up. There are many people who have decided views on the subject, and prominent among them is Mr. Lawrence Ginnell, the Nationalist member for Westmeath in the British Parliament.



Mr. Ginnell maintains that he possesses sufficient information to dissolve the mystery once and for all. On several occasions he has made valiant attempts to induce the House of Commons to hear his views on the subject. Solemnly he arises, and members guess what is coming. Mr. Ginnell in Ginnell, M.P. forms the House that he is in a position to make shocking revelations, and just as he is getting into his stride it is discovered that most of the members have disappeared and the House is counted out. "Tis very strange, and curious-minded people outside the House would like to see Mr. Ginnell given a free hand to probe the mystery. The member for Westmeath declares that the jewels could be recovered at any time, and a great scandal is being hushed up to save persons in high places. In fact, Mr. Ginnell recently called on the Irish Secretary "to lay them on the table of the House." A roar went up at the possible prospect of English, Irish, Scotch and Welsh, to say nothing of other nationalities, scrambling for the precious jewels.

In private life there is no suggestion of the sleuth-hound about Mr. Ginnell. He wears a beard and a well-fitting frock coat. Though he is self-educated, he is a member of both the Irish and English Bars, and helped to found the Irish Literary Society in London. He has written on "Land and Liberty," and may one day write on what appeals to him as the greatest of all mysteries, under some such title as "Och, the Jewels."

Scotch Sun Dial.

Record is contained in the Bible of a sun-dial set up in 771 B. C. by Ahaz to commemorate the miraculous healing of his son Hezekiah. A very ancient one was recently discovered lying in the grounds of the ruined castle of Finlarig, Killin, Perthshire, Scotland, the ancient seat of the Breadalbanes. Unlike most dials, it has twelve planes for recording the hours and two circular planes for use in summer and winter respectively. For many centuries the occupants of the castle deciphered its many angles as it stood reared on a tall pedestal, reflected in the waters of a fountain. The interval of nearly 2,000 years between this dial and that set up by Ahaz shows for how long the dial held its own as an object of utility.

A Royal M. D.

The only royal doctor of medicine is ex-Queen Marie Amelia of Portugal. Not only is she devoted to the healing art, which she studies with such success, but she is persistently successful as an exponent of hygienic dressing. Tight lacing is to her an utter abomination. Though an exile, she spends something like three-fourths of her large annual income yet upon the poor of Portugal. Her charities include experimental stations for the production of the serum of diphtheria, a dread disease much prevalent in Portugal; a model sanitary bakery for Lisbon slum dwellers; and a hospital and free dispensary for stricken women. Florence Nightingale was a great friend of Queen Marie, and her Majesty often conferred with "the heroine of the Crimea" concerning her hospital work, and derived much aid from the practical counsel thus obtained.

ARMENIAN WEDDING LONG.

"Happy Man" a Paradox Through Taxing Celebration.

An Armenian wedding is not readily forgotten. It lasts for several days, and starts with a general meeting of friends and relatives, who are entertained by a band of minstrels and dancers until the arrival of the groom. In the midst of the uproar it is Armenian etiquette that the "happy" man shall totter in with faltering footsteps and blanched face (it has just been whitened with a little powder) in order to go through the ordeal of preparation.

He is first publicly shaved, and then adorned with the various gifts sent by the bride-elect. His brothers next fall upon him, and with such vigor that he speedily stands forth as Nature made him. Then they completely reclothe him in new garments as best they can—a difficult job, when one remembers that custom forces them to hold candles in their right hands throughout the operation.

The evening terminates with bonfires, more music, and much dancing. Upon the following evening the bride puts in her first appearance by riding to church—the bridegroom walks. The priest meets them at the porch, and reads them a very reasonable little homily upon the obligations they are about to undertake. They next march in procession to the altar, where their foreheads are bound together with gold chains.

Even then, however, another three days must elapse before the expectant groom is allowed to take possession. They are a long-suffering race, the Armenians.

Explaining "Horse-power."

The average man is apt to speak very glibly of so many hundred or thousand horse-power, but it is extremely doubtful whether one person in a hundred has a due appreciation of what the phrase really means. Calculating the strength of twelve men to be equal to one horse-power, it would require 840,000 men to produce as much energy as the 70,000 horse-power developed by the turbine machinery of a big Atlantic steamer. Then, if the men were to work on the eight-hour-day system, those figures would give a total of 2,520,000, that being the number of men whose strength would be necessary to drive the vessel across the Atlantic Ocean.
