LEAP YEAR PROPOSALS LEGAL

Woman Originally Given Right by Statutes.

Although most women are well aware of the great privilege which they may enjoy during leap year, it is not to be presumed that they are all equally conversant with the fact that their premarital right was originally secured to them by a statute law of England, enacted in 1606 under James I. (1603-1625), which readeth thus: "Albeit it is now become a part of the common laws, in regarde to the social relations of life, that so often as everie besextile year doeth returne, the ladies have the sole privilege, during the time continueth, of making love unto the men, which they may doe, either by words or looks, as unto them seemeth proper; moreover, no man will be entitled to the benefit of clergy who dothe refuse to accept the offers of a ladye, or who dothe in any wise treat her proposals with slight and contumely."

A Scotch statute of 1228, under Alexander II. (1214-1249), however, preceded the above, and will appear to be even more stringent:

"It is statet and ordaint that during the year of his maist blisist majestie, ilk fourth year known as leap year, ilk maiden lady of both high and low estait, shall hae liberty to bespeak ye man she likes, albit, if he refuses to take her to be his wife he shall be mulcted in the sum of one poundis (£1) or less, as his estait may be, except and anis if he can make it appear that he is betrothed to ane woman, that he shall then be free."

SIDE-STEPPING PNEUMONIA.

Chicago Health Bureau Tells How to Avoid Infection.

Rules for "side stepping" pneumonia are offered in unique form by the Chicago department of health in a recent bulletin and causes of the infectious disease made plain. Under the caption, "Some things you should know about pneumonia," these conditions which render infection probable are listed:

"Contact with a pneumonia patient. Working in a dusty, poorly ventilated place. Living in rooms that are unventilated or too hot and dry. Sleeping in an unventilated room. Eating more or less food than the system needs in relation to work, exercise and exposure. Drinking alcoholics. Excessive work. Lack of sleep. Worry and grief. Other diseases. Unseasonable clothing.

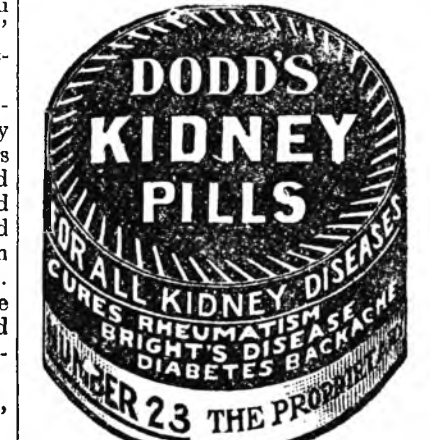
