Four petitions have been filed against the seating of Mr. James Morris the Conservative member elect in Chateaugay, Quebec. Bribery by himself and by agents is alleged.

A. R. Bredin was unanimously nominated by the Liberals of Kildonan and St. Andrew's, Manitoba, in convention at Selkirk, to oppose Hon. Dr. Montague, the new Provincial Minister of Public Works.

Mr. A. J. H. Eckardt of Toronto was tendered a complimentary banquet Friday night at the Tremont House, Markham, by members of the lawn bowling clubs entering into the Eckardt Trophy competition.

Jos. A. Todd, postmaster at Stouffville, died Thursday night at his home. He had been suffering from Bright's disease and his condition had been serious during the previous week. Mr. Todd had been postmaster for about two years.
