#### RACE BETTERMENT.

Important Conference Will Be Held at Battle Creek, Michigan.

A working plan having as its ultimate purpose the building of a perfect race of mortals is to be formulated at the National Conference on Race Betterment to be held in Battle Creek, Michigan, on January 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12, 1914.

Intermediately the plan contemplates gradual betterment of living conditions, the achievement of increased human efficiency; and higher standards of physical and mental development.

For several years increasing interest has been centred upon the problems which the Conference has elected to consider. The much-discussed eugenics movement is one of the channels in which this interest defined femininist movement is another out-cropping of the general groping for new race ideals. These and correlated topics will be considered at the coming Conference. years.

The organization of a national body to continue the work inaugurated by the Conference itself, will be affected. This national body, it is anticipated, will arrange for an- U.S.A. nual meetings and in a very short time will lay the foundation for a world movement for an improved race.

The list of those who will take part in the Conference includes many men and women of national prominece.

During the progress of the Conerence there will be a comprehensive mental and physical classification of several hundred school children, which will take into consideration the effect of heredity and environment upon the offspring.

Stardards of mental and physical perfection will be determined and a general campaign to secure the world-wide adoption of these standards as a true test of mankind will be among the other topics to be considered by the Conference.

#### THE WORLD'S BOOK LIST.

Germany Leads the World, With Russla Second.

The Madrid Heraldo prints some statistics of the number of books published in 1911, that throw an interesting light on the literary and intellectual activity of various nations, and incidentally reveal some surprising facts. The statistics have been gathered with great care by the distinguished Spanish author, Eduardo Ravarro Salvador.

According to the figures of Senor Salvador, Germany leads the world in the number of books published with 33,000. Of course that is the number of literary works published, not the

total number of books printed.
Strangely enough, Russia is second with 29,060. Twenty-four thousand works were published in Japan—more than double the number, 11,123, that United States produced. Great Britain, Italy, France and Switzerland follow close on the United States: these countries published respectively, 11,000, 10,929, 10,400 and 10,000 works. Austria-Hungary published 7,00 books; the Scandinavian countries-Denmark, Sweden and Norway,-6,475; the Balkan states, 4,000; Holland, 3,-700. Spain and Portugal set the low water mark of literary achievement; only 2,665 works were published in

these two countries. That Russia and Japan should each produce more than twice as many literary works as the United States s not more surprising than that the United States and Switzerland should publish virtually the same number The low mark of Spain and Portugal, countries in which culture has existed for so many centuries, and reached so high a standard, is also worthy of

Considered in connection with the population of the countries, these statistics are still more startling. Switzerland, for instance, published four times as many works per capita as its nearest rival. It leads the world with 2,702 for each million inhabitants. Because of their mild, soothing, and The other countries follow in this order: Holland, Japan, Germany, Italy, 122 books published for every million inhabitants,-the United States.


