

HOW BRITAIN TREATS ENEMY.

Prisoners to Have Old English Mansion to Themselves.

The London Daily Mail says the British Government, at a cost of FOUND \$100,000, has converted Donington Hall, Leicestershire, one of the most beautiful old halls in England, into a home of rest for captured German officers, of whom it will accommodate nearly three hundred.

There are about sixty acres of parkland, with spacious lawns and charming views across the valley of the Trent. The house is finely appointed and contains a dining-room with carved oak panels, and a carved and polished elm ceiling, a smoking lounge, equal to that of a good hotel, six bathrooms with hot and cold water, and a shower bath; also a medical ward with a doctor and constant attendants. Electric light has been installed and all the compartments are heated.

There is also a canteen from which the prisoners can obtain wines and spirits of all the principal brands They will be waited upon by Ger man valets, shaved by German barbers and served with food by German waiters, captured in the Ger man ranks.

Alongside the hall is an old chapel with stained glass windows, in which a German priest will conduct services. Beneath the window is the text of "Peace on Earth, Good Will Toward Men."
