HOW EXPLOSIVES KILL

Awful Effects of the French Shrapnel Shells.

It will be recalled that on the morrow of the battle of the Marne returned combatants related strange stories of the aspect of certain German unwounded corpses, says London Tit-Bits. Death as been so instantaneous that the bodies remained in a lifelike posture, some shouldering a rifle, others pipe in mouth. In a communication made to the Academy of Medicine, M. Rene Arnnoux asserts that the phenomena was due to the efficacy of the French explosives. Within a 15-yard radius of the point where the shell explodes the displacement of the air is so intense as to destroy the equilibrium of pressure on the interior and exterior of the human body. The gas contained in the blood is thus liberated, causes a distension of the blood vessels and arteries, and, ultimately bursting those organs, induces sudden death. This argument is confirmed by the state of the bodies, which often showed the heart and liver greatly distended and numerous internal hemorrhages.


