At the last meeting of the King Township Council the following resolution was passed:

McCabe-Kaake—Whereas in view of the fact that there is a Law upon the Statutes of Ontario compelling all Electric Railways to carry passengers at the rate of Two Cents per mile, and Whereas the Schomberg and Aurora Electric Railway are now charging Three Cents per mile, be it Resolved that this Council request the management of the said Company to regulate the fares for carrying passengers in conformity with the Statutes of Ontario by May 15th, 1917. Further be it Resolved should the said Railway Company not comply with the Statutes by May 15th that this Council will immediately appeal to the Ontario Railway Board for redress.

## Smut in Grain Decreases Yield

In 1915 we had one of the worst outbreaks of Smut in the history of our Province. The loss has been estimated at \$5,000,000. A great many farmers treated their seed grain in 1916 and it is just as necessary in 1917

### TREAT YOUR SEED FOR SMUT

The method usually adopted is as follows:—Mix one pint of formalin with 40 gallons of water, or 2 tablespoonfuls to 1 pail of water. Place the grain to be treated in a heap on clean canvass or floor. Sprinkle the formalin solution over the grain, then shovel. Repeat this until every grain is moistened by the solution; then cover the pile with sack and leave for 3 or 4 hours. At the end of this time spread the grain out thinly to dry; shovelling it over three or four times will hasten the drying. One pint of formalin in solution is sufficient to sprinkle thirty or forty bushels of grain, smaller amounts in proportion. Immersing the grain in a bag is sometimes practised and is equally effective.

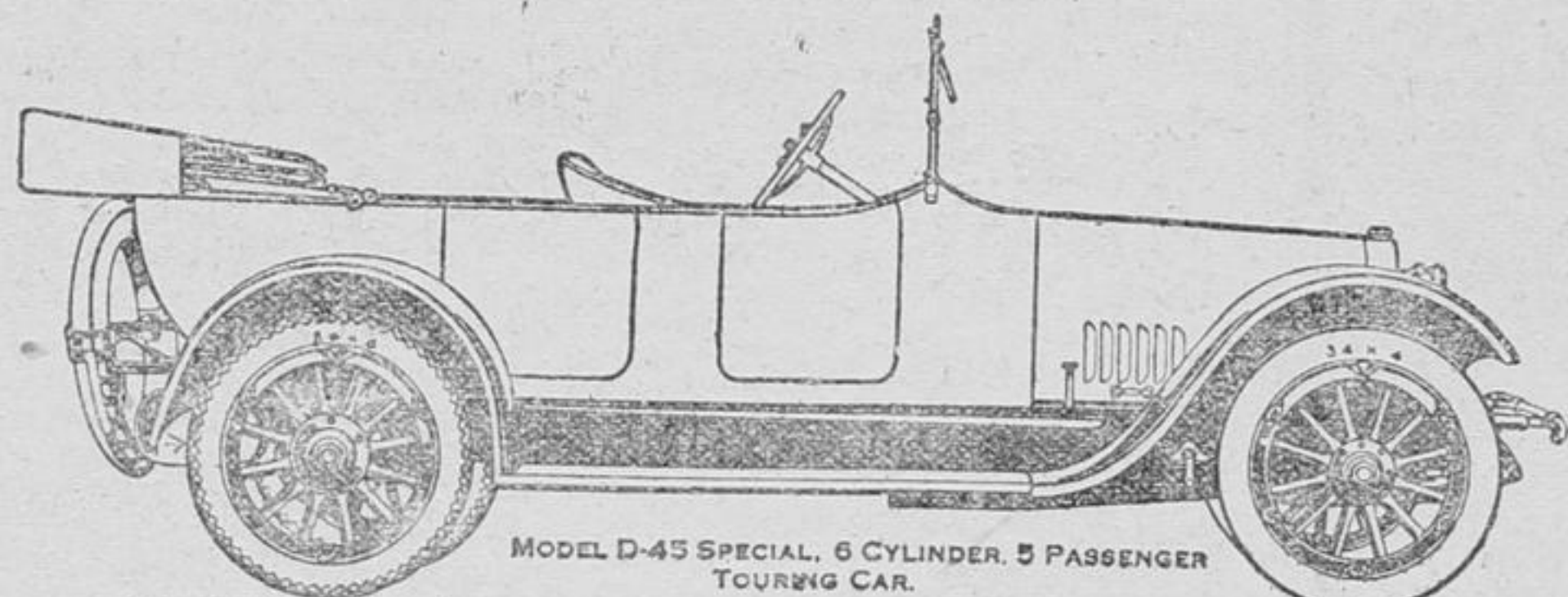
