The Evening Telegram of Tuesday says: "The solution of the Irish problem is none of Canada's business." But Premier Lloyd George says it is everybody's business, as it endangers the peace of the world. Listen to what the Premier said in a speech at Guild Hall last week: "We must convert Ireland from a suspicious, surly, dangerous neighbor to a cheerful, loyal comrade. Settlement of the Irish question is essential for the peace of the world and essential to a speedy victory in the war. I appeal to the patriotism of all men to sink everything for the one purpose of getting this question out of the way."

On the initiative of Mayor Church the Toronto City Council, by a vote of 17 to 5, has passed a resolution to petition the Dominion Parliament to refuse the franchise to any voter at any election, born in an enemy country who has lived in Canada less than 25 years. There is not the least likelihood of any Parliament in the British Dominions passing such a measure. To expect naturalized subjects to pay their taxes and obey the laws of a country, and take away their votes seems unfair and un-British.

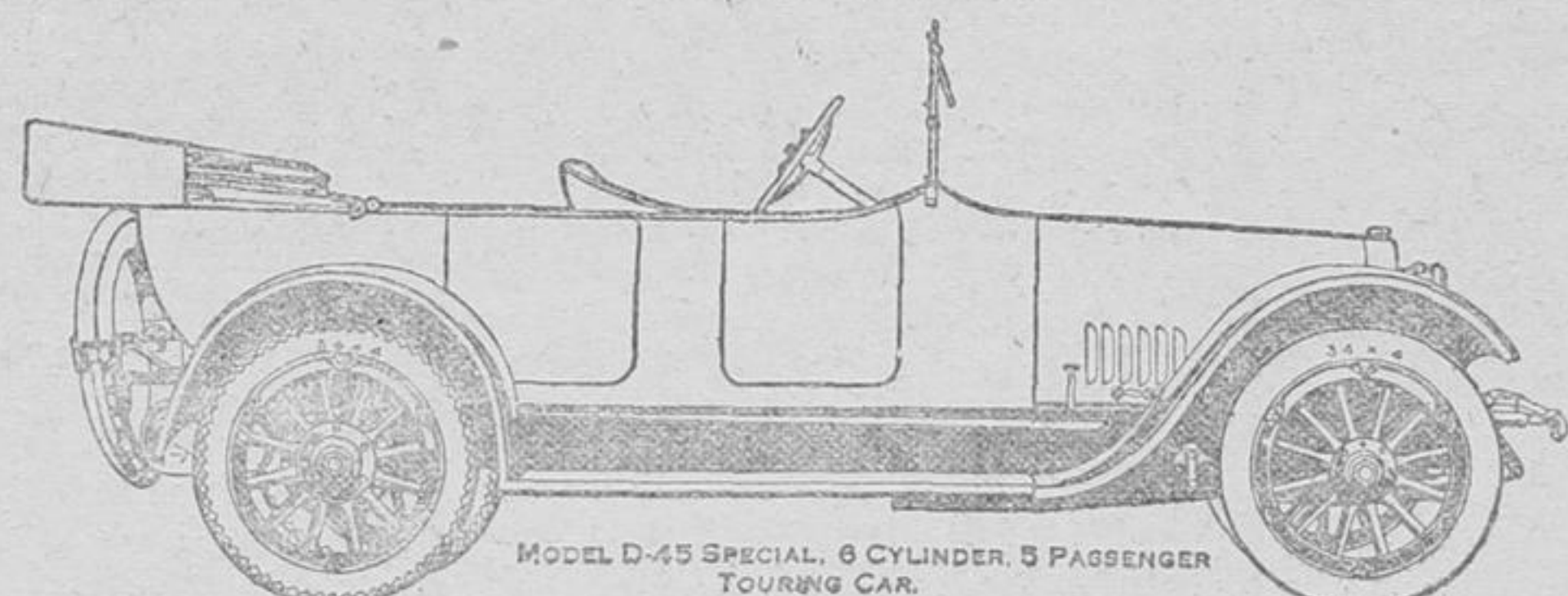
