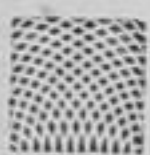

MOST UNJUST

Field Marshal Joffre, the famous soldier of France, the hero of the Marne, is rightly pictured as one of the big men of the day. Judged by an editorial in the Evening Telegram of Saturday, however, he is one of the smallest.

The Telegram's expression of censure is that Joffre arranged a visit to Montreal that has shown indifference in recruiting, but goes by Toronto that has done so well in recruiting.

If the Telegram wished to take a charitable view it might say that the Marshal went where he is needed more.

The Telegram also says that the visit to this continent was "meant to recruit soldiers for France," but that now "there is danger of its being turned into a scheme to recruit votes for Laurier."

The Telegram does not do itself justice in making such an insinuation against one of the foremost men of day.

IT CONCERNS THE WORLD

The Mail and Empire had the following editorial note:—"It must be extremely satisfactory to Germany to see Canadian and American public men meddling in a matter that concerns Great Britain alone, namely, "Home Rule for Ireland."

Such paragraphs as the above go to show that the Mail is not keeping abreast of the times. Mr. Balfour told a deputation in Washington that the British Government is doing everything possible to bring the north of Ireland and the south of Ireland together in a Home Rule arrangement.

Lloyd George pleads with the Ulsterites and the Nationalists to sink their prejudices for the good of the Empire, as the peace of the world is endangered. It is folly to say that the question of "Home Rule concerns great Britain alone."

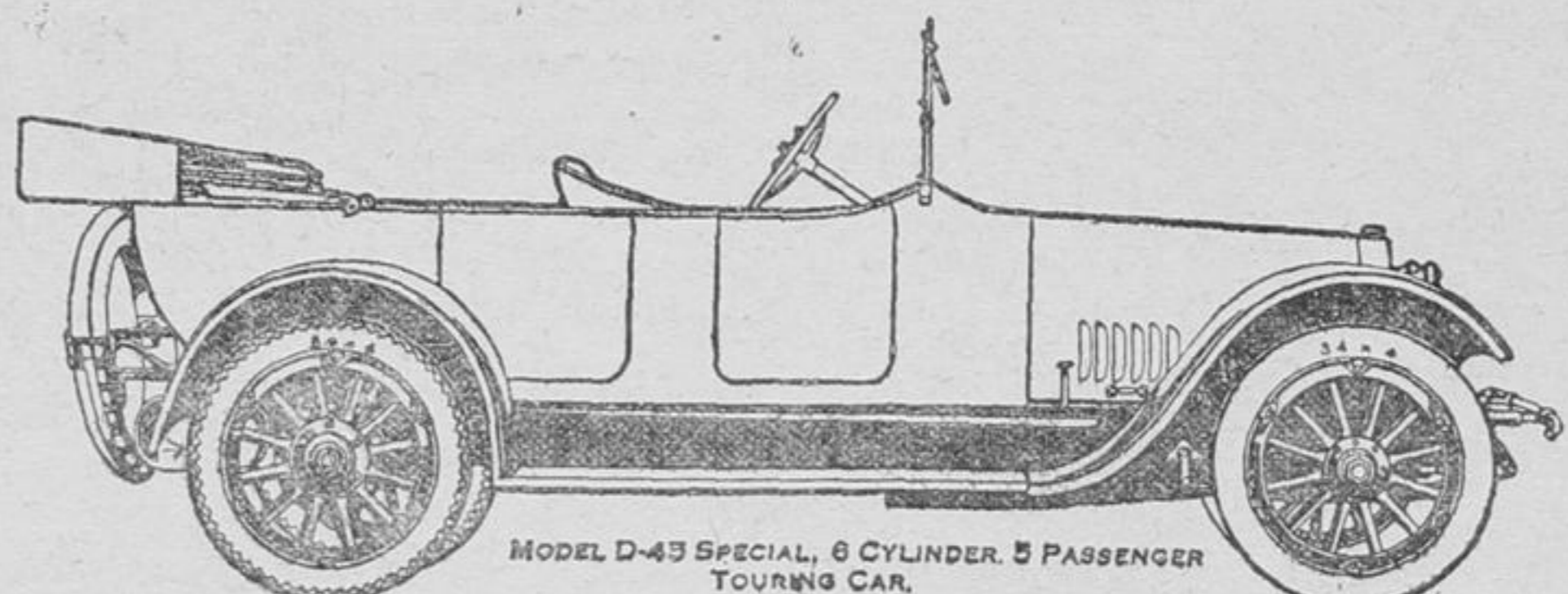
