


They are cooked like marrowfat peas, soaked overnight and boiled for twenty-five minutes the next day. In early times "carlins" were eaten very generally on Carlin or Passion Sunday. They are light brown color outside and cream colored under the skin and sell for from eight to twelve cents a pound, much less than beans and peas.






