NO WAR ELECTION

The Ontario Legislature opened last week with, apparently, the best of feeling on both sides of the house. One of the first acts of courtesy was a plea by Mr. Proudfoot, the new leader of the opposition for an extension of the life of Parliament until the war is over, and the soldiers will be back to record their votes. Sir William Hearst, the Prime Minister, in reply, expressed his concurrence with the views of the Liberal leader.

That means, therefore, that there will be no general election during the continuance of the war. This should give general satisfaction, as the average man and woman has already all and more than he can do. Not saying anything about the men needed on the firing line, thousands of men are needed in the great work of increasing food production all over the Dominion. Everything considered would it not seem folly to divide the political parties into two hostile camps.

DAYLIGHT SAVING

During the last session of the Dominion Parliament a bill was introduced

having for its object the saving of daylight four months of summer. The bill was thoroughly discussed, but as there was much difference of opinion it was withdrawn. The idea seems to be to induce people to retire to bed an hour earlier than in the past, thus saving an hour electric, gas or other light. Workmen in factories, shops and other places, who in the past have gone to work at 7 a. m. would be expected to start at 6 a. m., and quit one hour earlier in the evening. In all probability the bill will be again introduced during next session. It is said the United States will endeavour to carry a similar measure.

Surely the Metropolitan could have delivered the Mail on Saturday before night, as transfer of passengers were made between York Mills and Willowdale during the earlier part of the day. Why could not the mails have been taken overland as well?
