Prince Exhibits Canadian Gifts.

The Prince of Wales has arranged for a selection of the presents and addresses he received in Canada to be exhibited at the Imperial Institute, says a London despatch. The collection comprises about 200 addresses, from various sections of the community, from the Canadian Government to the pupils of Indian native schools. The membership card of the Great War Veterans' Association and the badge of the President of the Grand Army of Canada are of special interest.

One of the most interesting exhibits is the dress presented to the Prince on his election to the tribe of Stoney Indians as Chief "Morning Star." The gold railway pass presented by the Canadian Pacific Railway is shown, to-Trunk Railway, consisting of photographs taken in 1860 and 1901, enclosed in a box of bird's eye maple. These include, besides, the chief official photographs of King Edward VII. as Prince of Wales, and the present King.

The collection is arranged in the Canadian section of the exhibition galleries. The Queen has paid a private visit to the exhibition.
