NEWS NOTES

"From the data, as far as obtained, the committee has found no evidence to warrant the hope that a specific cure for cancer has been discovered by Dr. Glover or that a cure has been produced by the serum in any case definitely established as cancer."

Such is the finding in the interim report of the special committee of the Academy of Medicine named to investigate the Dr. T. F. Glover cancer treatment.

Hon. S. C. Biggs, Minister of Public Works, has been successful in finding, through his engineers, a possible diversion of Yonge Street that will prove one of most important advantages that the highway system can give to Toronto by removing the heavy grades at northern entrance. The grade at Hogg's Hollow will be taken away. "By a simple diversion through Armour Heights," explained an official of the department, "we follow the high land for some distance, and then by a viaduct, about 800 feet long, we are able to eliminate all the heavy grades at Hogg's Hollow."
