

The story of a modern Robinson Crusoe who for thirty years has lived on a lonely island in the Arafura Sea, between Australia and New Guinea, is told by Mr. W. Somerset Maugham, the English playwright, who has just returned from a fifteen months' tour in the East.

"I had chartered a lugger for a cruise in the Arafura Sea,' he said, "and I was asked to drop a bag of rice on the island for this old hermit.

"I learned on the way from those who had already seen him that he was shipwrecked thirty years ago, and with fifteen other men reached the island in open boats. They lived on the island for three years before they were sighted by a passing ship.

"Of the sixteen only five were then alive, and only four were taken away -for the fifth, the old man living there now, refused to leave.

"He told the rescuers that during the three years he had spent with the other men on the island he had seen such horrible things that he wished never to live among his kind again.

"During the thirty years he has been on the island," added Mr. Maugham, "the old man has lived on chickens, eggs, fish, and fruit.

"During the war he was left alone for five years, for no ships passed his way, and he was reduced to living entirely upon what the island could produce"


